The Preaching of Repentance Prepares Us for the Coming of the Lord

The preaching & Baptism “*of repentance for the forgiveness of sins*” (Luke 3:3) prepare us for the coming of the Lord, Jesus Christ. 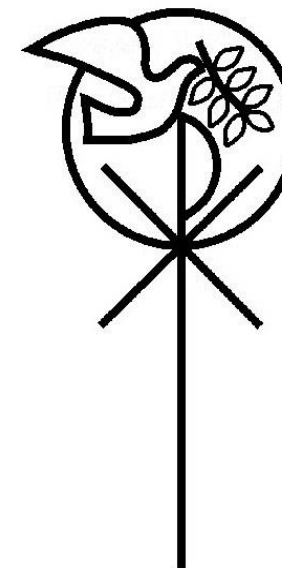
