Concerning the Lord’s Supper

The Lord’s Supper is celebrated in this congregation in the confession and glad confidence that, as He says, our Lord gives into our mouths not only bread and wine but His true body and blood to eat and to drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our union with Him and with one another. Our Lord invites to His table those who trust in His words, repent of all sin, and set aside any refusal to forgive and love as He forgives and loves us, that they may show forth His death until He comes.

Because those who eat and drink our Lord’s body and blood in an inappropriate manner do so to their great harm, and because Holy Communion is a confession of the faith confessed at this congregation’s altar, any who are not yet instructed, in doubt, or who hold a confession of faith differing from that of this congregation and The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod are asked to refrain from receiving the sacrament until they have spoken with the Pastor.

The Lord Jesus Comes in Humility to Redeem Us

The season of Advent focuses on the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, & this first Sunday establishes this theme for the rest of the season. The Son of God came long ago to be our Savior, **“a righteous Branch”** descended from David (Jer. 33:15). As He then came into Jerusalem, riding on a lowly donkey to sacrifice Himself for the sins of the world (Luke 19:28–40), so does He come to His Church today in the humility of Word & Sacrament to deliver the fruits of His Passion: the forgiveness of sins & eternal life. He absolves us & establishes our hearts **“blameless in holiness before our God and Father”** (1 Thess. 3:13). The same Lord Jesus, who came to Jerusalem then & who comes to us now in peace, will come again with power & great glory on the Last Day. Then there will be **“distress of nations in perplexity,”** with **“people fainting with fear.”** Yet, as we anticipate that great & terrible day, He bids us to rest securely in Him: **“Raise your heads, because your redemption is drawing near”** (Luke 21:25, 26, 28).

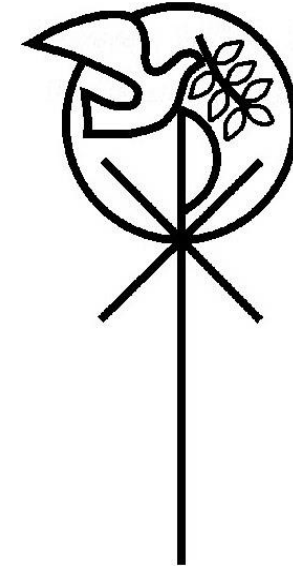
