Concerning the Lord's Supper

The Lord's Supper is celebrated in this congregation in the confession and glad confidence that, as He says, our Lord gives into our mouths not only bread and wine but His true body and blood to eat and to drink for the forgiveness of sins and to strengthen our union with Him and with one another. Our Lord invites to His table those who trust in His words, repent of all sin, and set aside any refusal to forgive and love as He forgives and loves us, that they may show forth His death until He comes.

Because those who eat and drink our Lord's body and blood in an inappropriate manner do so to their great harm, and because Holy Communion is a confession of the faith confessed at this congregation's altar, any who are not yet instructed, in doubt, or who hold a confession of faith differing from that of this congregation and The Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod are asked to refrain from receiving the sacrament until they have spoken with the Pastor.

Jesus Christ Is Our Champion Against the Devil

Jesus Christ, our champion against the devil, endures and overcomes **“every temptation”** (Luke 4:13) on our behalf. He worships the Lord, His God, and serves Him only by trusting the Word of His Father: **“You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased”** (Luke 3:22). Jesus' victory is now ours through His gracious Word, which is not far away but near us — in our mouth and in our heart, in the proclamation of repentance and faith. For **“with the heart one believes and is justified, and with the mouth one confesses and is saved”** (Rom. 10:10). Our confession of Christ includes the prayer of faith, which is not disappointed, **“for ‘everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved’”** (Rom. 10:13). The Lord is not oblivious to **“our affliction, our toil, and our oppression”** (Deut. 26:7), but has mercy upon us. He has brought us out of bondage through the **“signs and wonders”** of Holy Baptism, **“with a mighty hand and an outstretched arm”** (Deut. 26:8), and now He leads us by His Spirit even in the wilderness.

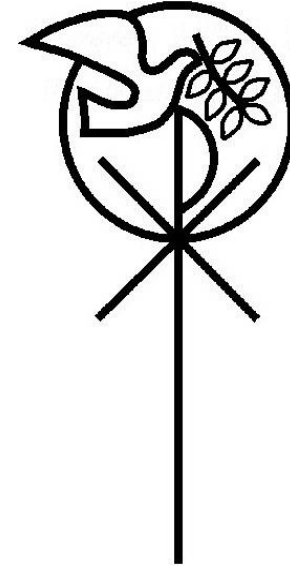
